

Know All Men by these Presents, That we,

*William E. Smith*

as sureties, all of the County of *Dodge* in the State of *Wisconsin*,

Are held and firmly bound, unto the State of Wisconsin, in the penal sum of *two thousand*  
*dollars* lawful money of the United States, to be paid to the said State, for which payment well and

truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and each of our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by  
these presents. Witness our hands and seals this *tenth* day of *May* A. D. 186*0*.

The condition of this Bond is such, that whereas, the above bounden principals are the Directors of *the*  
*Uniformed Volunteer Company*

known and styled *as the*  
*"Citizens Guard"*

and belonging to the *22d* Regiment,  
*1st* Brigade, *6th* Division of the Militia of said State,

And whereas the Governor of the said State, has, in pursuance of the Laws of the said State, delivered to the said  
Directors for the use of the said Company, the following Arms and Military Accoutrements, the property of the said State,

- to wit:
- 4 non-com. officers sword, belt, and plates.*
  - 40 bright percussion muskets, bayonets and scabbards.*
  - 40 cartridge boxes & plates - 40 cap pouches.*
  - 40 Cartridge box belts & plates - 40 waist belts & plates.*
  - 40 gun slings - 10 wipes - 10 tube wrenches - 20 tubes -*
  - 2 Spring vices*
- all valued at the sum of *twelve hundred dollars*.

Now if the said Directors shall safely keep the said Arms and Military Accoutrements, and deliver the same  
in good order, on the order of the Governor of the said State, or on the order of the person duly authorized by  
the Governor for that purpose, and at such place within the State as the Governor shall direct; and further, in  
case such Directors shall not suffer the said Arms and Military Accoutrements, or any of them, to be removed  
from the limits of the said County of *Dodge* without the consent of the Governor first had  
and obtained, then and in such case, this Bond shall be void, otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and  
virtue.
